A starter pack is included in the rent. Taxes, duties and normal electricity consumption (up to 6 kWh/day) are included.

A baby up to 15 kg can sleep in the cot and does not count as a person. In the case of long-term rental (1 month or longer), the tenant is expected to do his own household linen and equip himself with the necessary accessories (e.g. toilet paper).

Flat-rate supplements:

- Bed linen and towels: 10 CHF per person per change
- Baby bed with sheets: 40 CHF
- Final cleaning: 35 CHF (up to 2 people) / 40 CHF (from 3 people)
- Supplement for pets: 20 CHF per cleaning
- Use of washing machine (9 kg): 2x per week free of charge, additional use 5 CHF each

Charcoal and firewood for the garden fireplace and the wood stove (filled wooden box in Apt. #1): Once a week, the available fuel may be used. If you need more, please buy it yourself: charcoal is available in every mini-market, firewood from the neighbor or in the agricultural shop. The wood supply in the garden is reserved for the winter.

The apartments may also be advertised on Airbnb, Booking. Due to automatic adjustment of prices (exchange rate, demand) and the brokerage surcharge, the total rent may differ there.

*) Monthly rent = 30 or 31 nights. It is not the calendar month that counts, but the actual start of the rental period.

**) The largest consumer of electricity is the A/C air conditioner. When used sparingly, 2-3 kWh/day is sufficient, which is why the exemption limit was set at 6 kWh/d.
