A starter pack is included in the rent. Taxes and normal electricity consumption (up to 6 kWh/day and apartment\*\*), as well as 5 GB internet/week are included.

A baby up to 15 kg can sleep in the cot and does not count as a person. In the case of long-term rental (1 month or longer), the tenant is expected to do his own household laundry and equip himself with the necessary accessories (e.g. toilet paper).

#### Flat-rate supplements:

- Tourist tax: 8 EUR/night and apartment (as of Feb 2025, may change)
- Bed linen and towels: 10 CHF per person and change
- Unlimited internet: 25 CHF per month
- Baby cot with bed linen: 40 CHF
- Final cleaning per apt: 30 CHF (up to 2 persons) / 40 CHF (from 3 persons)
- Pet supplement: 20 CHF per cleaning
- Use of washing machine (9 kg): 2x per week free of charge, additional use 5 CHF each

Charcoal and firewood for the garden fireplace: The available fuel may be used once a week. If you need more, please buy it yourself: Charcoal is available in every mini-market. The wood supply in the garden is reserved for the winter, so please use it sparingly.

The apartments may also be advertised on booking platforms. Due to automatic adjustment of prices (exchange rate, demand) and the brokerage surcharge, the total rent may differ there.

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\*) Monthly rental = 30 or 31 nights. It is not the calendar month that counts, but the effective start of the lease.

\*\*) Unfortunately, we cannot benefit from our own solar power on the upper floor (except air conditioners). If the devices are used sparingly, 2-3 kWh/day is sufficient, which is why the exemption limit was set at 6 kWh/day and apartment.
